A sick tortoise

She received her doctorate in viruses of tortoises from the Justus Liebig Univ. and her habilitation in Environmental and Animal Hygiene and Veterinary Virology from the Univ. of Hohenheim, Stuttgart, Germany. She is a diplomate of the European College of Zoological Medicine (ECZM) in herpetological medicine as well as a certified specialist for microbiology. She is a past president of The Association of Reptilian and Amphibian Veterinarians (ARAV) and the current president of the ECZM. She has authored over 100 peer-reviewed papers and multiple book chapters and has presented hundreds of papers at international conferences. She is currently working as a consultant veterinarian for reptile diagnostics at Laboklin GmbH & Co. KG in Bad Kissingen, Germany and as an adjunct professor at the Univ. of Hohenheim in Stuttgart.
