Anastasia, an Italian greyhound with fever of unknown origin

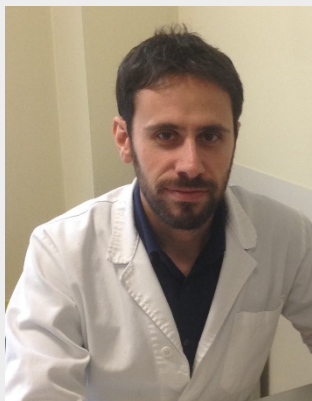
Dear colleagues,
