The fever horse - Equine Coronavirus; a new emerging disease?

Dear colleagues,

Today we would like to invite you to our next webseminar on: "The fever horse - Equine Coronavirus; a new emerging disease?"

Although Equine Coronavirus (ECoV) has been known to cause diarrhoea in foals for decades, it has increasingly been detected in adult horses (>2 years) in recent years. In this age group, the focus is mainly on febrile diseases, rarely accompanied by gastrointestinal symptoms such as diarrhoea or colic. Recent years show that a large proportion of infections with ECoV run subclinical or can result in asymptomatic shedding of the virus. Due to new findings, ECoV should be considered as a differential diagnosis, not only in foals, but also in adult horses showing fever of unknown origin with or without gastrointestinal symptoms. This web seminar illuminates the medical approach, such as clinical examination and the correct laboratory diagnostics in a patient presented with high fever as the main symptom, and gives some background information on Equine Coronavirus and its differential diagnoses.
